RULES & REGULATIONS

These Rules & Regulations are to be read in conjunction with The Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G under which this show is licensed. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the Kennel Club G Regulations available from the Kennel Club.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed obedience shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club regulations for classification and registration B.
2. In classes without a full running order dogs will be received until one hour after the commencement of judging (11.00am.) after which no dogs may be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the show management.
3. There is NO Prize money on offer at this show.
4. The committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. All dogs registered and resident outside the U.K. must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an authority to compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
6. Animals allowed in Event. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dog registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes, or by permission of the general committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show. With the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
7. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed obedience shows.
8. A dog shall be disqualified and removed from the show if it is:-
 - a) A bitch which is in season.
 - b) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
 - c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
9. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
10. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
12. Should circumstances so dictate the society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
13. All offers of sponsorship or donation must be included with the name of the sponsors.
14. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the society.
15. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the show management.
16. No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the general committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the canine press wherever possible.
17. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged Four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their full details recorded on the entry form.
18. Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
19. Welfare of Dogs: An exhibitor (or Competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met. and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
20. No official shall wear his/her badge whilst competing.
21. In the event of any cheque or money order not being honoured when first presented to the bank, the exhibitor shall be held liable for any bank charges or fees incurred. If the entry fee and such charges are not paid immediately upon request the exhibitor will be reported to the Kennel Club and will be dealt with by the Kennel Club committee.
22. Any competitors requiring confirmation of receipt of entries must enclose a S.A.E.
23. The club will not be held liable for any loss or damage arising from any cause what so ever.
24. DOG FOULING: Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any licensed K.C. show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches.
25. Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs left in cars/vans being found in distress.
26. If circumstances make it necessary that the show is cancelled, Newton Heath Dog Training Club. Reserves the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from the entry fee received.
27. Dogs under Six months and entered Not For Competition must not be exercised or trained within 10ft of any judging ring.
28. The use of clickers, whistles, squeaky toys or any other noise generating training aid within 30 feet of any ring is strictly forbidden.
29. ADULTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL CHILDREN IN THEIR CARE & MUST ENSURE THEY ARE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES.

1. In the following definitions of classes First Prize wins in Limited show Obedience classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Obedience Classes but do count for eligibility at Limited Obedience Shows confined to one breed.
2. A dog must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another standard class if desired, plus one additional special class if scheduled.
3. Society may schedule classes other than those defined below. The eligibility for "Special" classes must be defined by the society and included in the schedule. The word "Special" must be included in the title of the class.

PRE-BEGINNERS: To compete in Pre-Beginners a Handler or dog must not have won a First prize in either Pre-Beginners or Beginners, nor gained a third place or above in any other obedience class.

BEGINNERS: To compete in Beginners a Handler or Dog must not have won a total of two or more first prizes in beginners class or one first prize in any other class. (Pre-Beginners Excepted).

NOVICE: For dogs that have not won two first prizes in Obedience classes (Pre-Beginners and Beginners Excepted).

CLASS 'A': For dogs that have not won three first prizes in Class 'A', 'B' and Open Class 'C' in total.

CLASS 'B': For dogs that have not won three first prizes in Class 'B' and Open Class 'C' in total.

CLASS 'C': Open to all Dogs. (This includes Special Charity Class 'C')

SPECIAL GOOD CITIZEN SCHEME SPECIAL PRE-BEGINNER OBEDIENCE STAKES: To compete in this class a handler or dog must not have won a First prize in Pre-Beginners nor gained a third or above in any other standard obedience class.

Exhibits must have obtained their Kennel Club Good Citizen Dog Scheme Bronze Award prior to the closing date of the show. (28th JUNE 2011)

SPECIAL CHARITY CLASS 'C': is Based on a normal 'C' Round, however the appointed Judge may vary the content of the exercises should they wish to, provided it is not injurious to the dog/handler.

SPECIAL ABC CLASS FINAL: (Anything But a Collie) Only open to those dogs who have been placed not lower than 6th in this years heats. those held after 8th August 2010. The aim is to reward attitude and commitment. as well as accuracy. Rounds will in accordance with the lowest eligible class normally worked. Points will be earned For attitude, team work and positive handling. Handlers may choose which tests to work from their lowest eligible class up. There is no Scent or Stays in this class.

PLEASE NOTE:

You cannot enter any of the Special classes without also entering your lowest eligible class.

DIRECTIONS:-

STOCKPORT/M60 Anti Clockwise (From M6, M56, M61) Leave M60 at Junction 27, Stockport East (next alter Junction 1) M56 drivers the sequence is 1, (end of M56) then on the M60 2, 1, 27. At roundabout follow A626 Marple. **At 2nd set of Traffic Lights turn LEFT (still A626) Continue for about 4 Miles. After large MARPLE town sign at Traffic Lights Bear LEFT (Still A626 Glossop) Continue for about 1 Mile. The entrance is on the LEFT, Approx 50yds after Marple Railway Station (The Midland Hotel car park is opposite) Follow Park road down to Venue- **PLEASE NOTE 5 MPH SPEED LIMIT. FROM the M62/M60 Clockwise.** Leave at Junction 26 Stockport East, At roundabout follow A626 Marple. Then follow directions above from **

CAMPING DETAILS:

Campers must not arrive before 11am. on Friday 10th June. On entering Brabyns Park - **PLEASE NOTE 5 MPH SPEED LIMIT** - Follow Road round to the LEFT, passing car park on the left - Veer RIGHT through the trees. Continue on this road as it runs parallel to the park. At Second Fork (Building to the left) Veer RIGHT, Follow track down to the show ground. The Caravan/Camping parking is on the right of the road. You may park where you like at this side of the road, but all Caravans/Tents MUST be parked at least 20ft apart and be equipped with a fire extinguisher or a bucket of water at the front of the pitch. Barbecues are permitted and refreshments will be available.

Camping passes will NOT be issued but all campers will be checked in on arrival.

PLEASE NOTE. The entry gate will be LOCKED each night at 10pm and re-opened at 7am.

PETROL GENERATORS are NOT allowed at this venue - This is a Stockport Council Regulation and will be rigorously enforced. This is due to safety & Insurance issues.

DEFINITELY NO ADMITTANCE BEFORE 3pm ON FRIDAY.

CAMPERS/CARAVANERS MUST VACATE VENUE BY 7pm ON SUNDAY.
